HOW TO NETWORK LIKE A PRO

Networking is about making authentic, intentional connections. These strategies will help you navigate any event with confidence and purpose.

DO YOUR HOMEWORK: Review the attendee list (if available). Having a list of people you want to meet gives you direction—and eases anxiety.

GO IN WITH A GOAL: Your goal could be as simple as:

- Meet 3 new people
- Reconnect with someone you admire
- Share your current project or role Setting a small, achievable goal creates focus and momentum.

DITCH THE SALES PITCH: Networking isn't about closing a deal—it's about starting a conversation. Ask open-ended questions like:

- "What brought you to this event?"
- "What projects are you most excited about right now?" Listen more than you talk. People remember how you made them feel more than what you said.

WORK THE EDGES, NOT JUST THE CENTER: Introverts and first-timers often gather along the edges of a room. That's a great place to start a one-on-one chat before easing into larger groups.

ALWAYS FOLLOW UP: The real magic happens after the event. Send a short email or LinkedIn message. Mention something you discussed. It's what turns small talk into opportunity.

BONUS TIP: Don't try to meet everyone. Focus on meaningful over many—two quality conversations are better than 10 business card swaps.
